Growing in Faith...

Welcome to the weekly gathering of our church family. Our goal in everything is to praise God. Our aim is to grow in faith as we worship Him in Spirit and truth. If you were to become President of the USA, (I know, who would want that job) what would be your first "official act." Maybe that is too far fetched, so what if you were tomorrow promoted to boss, even for a day, what would you want to make sure would happen? I think I would have trouble narrowing down the list to what is most important. Would you fall prey to the power that suddenly rests in your hands, or would you think of and do something for others? In today's lesson we consider perhaps the most pivotal time in Jesus life, and what he chose to do with it. Listen and learn.



A Wedding of Sorts

This weekend I had the privilege of being a groomsman in one of my friend's wedding. Don't you enjoy weddings? Getting to hear the stories of how the two met, how they fell in love with each other, and of course how the groom proposed. It's truly a celebration followed by wonderful fellowship, hopefully great food, and perhaps even some meaningful speeches. As joyful as the wedding is with all of their stories and jokes and food, that's not what it is all about. People do not get married so that others may recognize the past the two have shared, but rather to recognize the future together that they will share. Is baptism not a wedding ceremony of sorts? We share our stories of how Christ has saved us from sin and death, and publicly confess before all that He is the sovereign King. It is an event to be taken very seriously, and not without truly understanding the cost of the decision. But the wedding ceremony is not the purpose of a marriage; the purpose of a wedding is to begin a life together, sacrificially for one another, as we tell each other our vows never to leave the other no matter the cost; in hopes of a fulfilled, complete life. We approach baptism too often as the end of the matter, a "get out of hell free" card rather than an important initial step of a lifetime of dedicated discipleship. This spiritual ceremony is not the climax, not the end of the story- but rather just the beginning. Jesus Christ professed His undying love for you on the cross, and invites each one of us not only into a wedding ceremony, but into a lifelong marriage. Once the cost of discipleship is assessed, He hopes you will accept His proposal. I do.
