Growing in Faith...

Welcome to the weekly gathering of our church family. Our goal in everything is to praise God. Our aim is to grow in faith as we worship Him in Spirit and truth. Our hope is that you find us a warm, welcoming, and serving group of people. If you are visiting with us today, welcome. We would love to get to know you and would appreciate it if you would fill out a Visitor's Card & pass it to the center aisle.

Try and imagine making an accurate description of someone you know quite well, your spouse or child, your parent of best friend. How about giving a description of someone you do not know well, an acquaintance, or visitor you just met this morning. Just how would you go about describing Jesus Christ? What words would you use? If you were asked to write a profile for Jesus, what would it say? In this morning's lesson we focus on who Jesus was "in the middle," between the time he began to preach to just before his last few days. We try to answer the question; Who do you say that I am?

A Heart-felt "Thank You?"

After a mad rush to the hospital in the middle of the night, and among frantic, panicking doctors and nurses, a soon-to-be mother and father were trying to soothe each others' nerves as various medications, needles, and scalpels were placed on the table for just such emergencies. However, there was light at the end of the tunnel, and not only the lights of the ambulance. Despite the complications, a beautiful baby boy was born to them. Some health experts explained months later though, that eventually his liver might give out and he would need a new one; he couldn't live a full life as he was. Soon after the young boy turned 4, he got terribly sick and was hospitalized. The family doctor explained to them that his liver was indeed shutting down, and he would need a replacement. The father, who was a dedicated coach and athlete himself, demanded that the surgeons take out his own liver so that his son might live. They explained that a liver can regenerate and that they could take half of his own for his son, but it would leave his own body very week for at least 8 months. Doctors said he would most likely need to sacrifice things he used to enjoy doing, but the dad didn't even blink as he signed all the paperwork. After the boy's stitches came out and the wounds healed, the progress he made was staggering, able to do things he never dreamed would be possible for him. He decided that in return for his daddy's sacrifice, he would set an alarm to go off once per week to remind him to say "thank you." Sounds inadequate doesn't it? But isn't that what we do in our own lives? Jesus paid the ultimate sacrifice to give us life, life to the full (John 10:10)- and in return we give 1, maybe 2 hours of our time to worship him. Our worship should be natural and often; not confined to a place or time. See Psalm 95 and 150.
